REQUEST OF: NATIONAL GRID

National Grid hereby respectfully requests your consent to the locations of mains as hereinafter described for the transmission and distribution of gas in and under the following public streets, lanes, highways, and places of the Town of Braintree and of the pipes, valves, governors, manholes and other structures, fixtures and appurtenances designed or intended to protect or operate said mains and accomplish the objects of said Company; and the digging up and opening the ground to lay or place same:

To install and maintain 475 feet more or less, of 2 inch gas main in Vine St., from the 2 inch gas main at River St., northerly to the end of the gas main at house #11. All of which to replace and abandon the existing 1 ½ inch and 2 inch gas mains in Vine St. with the following conditions:

BELD: Engineering has reviewed the NGRID Gas Petition #16-026 Vine St & River St.

PLEASE NOTE: BELD has two 115kV transmission lines located on River Street and in close proximity to the proposed scope of work. The 115kV line is a pressurized oil filled pipe type design encased in a thermal sand material with no protective concrete.

NGRID Gas should contact BELD Engineering prior to excavating near the 115kV transmission line. BELD will provide on-site safety personnel and engineering support at no cost to the project.

DPW: This section of River Street is under the moratorium. We would recommend that the petition for this section only be granted with conditions specified in the moratorium. Vine Street is not under the moratorium. The Town intends to resurface Vine Street this year, so prompt completion of the gas main installation would avoid coordination problems with the Town's contractor. We'd recommend that the petition for Vine Street be granted under the normal conditions, with emphasis on the requirements that the gas main be laid outside of the trench of the water mains in service and that the trench pavement not be left low for any length of time; We also recommend that the following requirement be added to the permit, if it is to be granted:

Neither National Grid nor any of its contractors is authorized to close any street or to close a direction of travel to facilitate their work without authorization from the Director of the Department of Public Works or the Highway Superintendent. The Chief of Police can also authorize a closure for a police or fire emergency. Construction zone traffic safety issues are to be addressed by using appropriate traffic control signs and devices and the use of police officers for traffic control to safely guide traffic through the work zone. If a closure is authorized by the DPW, it shall not be implemented until signs and police officers (where needed) are properly in place in conformity with the written plan prepared by the contractor's engineer and approved by the DPW and Police Department.





To install and maintain 475 feet more or less, of 2 inch gas main in Vine St., from the 2 inch gas main at River St., northerly to the end of the gas main at house #11. All of which to replace and abandon the existing 1 1/2 inch and 2 inch gas mains in Vine St.


