

PETITION OF NATIONAL GRID FOR GAS MAIN LOCATIONS



Town of Braintree / Town Council:

The Nationalgrid hereby respectfully requests your consent to the locations of mains as hereinafter described for the transmission and distribution of gas in and under the following public streets, lanes, highways and places of the **Town of Braintree** and of the pipes, valves, governors, manholes and other structures, fixtures and appurtenances designed or intended to protect or operate said mains and accomplish the objects of said Company; and the digging up and opening the ground to lay or place same:

To install and maintain approximately 475 feet more or less of 4 inch gas main in South St., Braintree. From the existing 2 inch gas main at house #15, southerly to the existing 4inch gas main at Woodedge Ave., and approximately 745 feet more or less of 2 inch gas main in Woodedge Ave., from the existing 4 inch gas main at South St., westerly to the end of the main at house #55, and approximately 200 feet more or less of 2 inch gas main in Woodedge Ln., from the proposed 2 inch gas main in Woodedge Rd., southerly to the end of the main at #1. All of which to replace and abandon the existing 2 inch gas mains in South St., Woodedge Ave., and Woodedge Ln.



REQUEST OF: NATIONAL GRID

National Grid hereby respectfully requests your consent to the locations of mains as hereinafter described for the transmission and distribution of gas in and under the following public streets, lanes, highways, and places of the Town of Braintree and of the pipes, valves, governors, manholes and other structures, fixtures and appurtenances designed or intended to protect or operate said mains and accomplish the objects of said Company; and the digging up and opening the ground to lay or place same:

To install and maintain approximately 475 feet of 4 inch gas main from the existing house 2 inch gas main at house #15, southerly to the existing 4 inch gas main at Woodedge Avenue, and approximately 745 feet of 2 inch gas main in Woodedge Avenue, from the existing 4 inch main at South Street, westerly to the end of the main at house #55, and approximately 200 feet more or less of 2 inch gas main in Woodedge Lane, from the proposed 2 inch gas main in Woodedge Road, southerly to the end of the main at #1. All of which to replace and abandon the existing 2 inch gas mains in South Street, Woodedge Avenue, and Woodedge Lane with the following conditions:

BELD: Engineering has reviewed the NGRID Gas Petition and finds no underground electric utility conflicts within the proposed scope of work.

DPW: These three streets are not under moratorium. We'd recommend that the petition be granted under the normal conditions, with emphasis on the requirements that the gas main be laid outside of the trench of the water mains in service and that the trench pavement not be left low for any length of time; We also recommend that the following requirement be added to the permit, if it is to be granted:

Neither National Grid nor any of its contractors is authorized to close any street or to close a direction of travel to facilitate their work without authorization from the Director of the Department of Public Works or the Highway Superintendent. The Chief of Police can also authorize a closure for a police or fire emergency. Construction zone traffic safety issues are to be addressed by using appropriate traffic control signs and devices and the use of police officers for traffic control to safely guide traffic through the work zone. If a closure is authorized by the DPW, it shall not be implemented until signs and police officers (where needed) are properly in place in conformity with the written plan prepared by the contractor's engineer and approved by the DPW and Police Department.
