PETITION OF NATIONAL GRID FOR GAS MAIN LOCATIONS

The National Grid hereby respectfully request your consent to the locations of mains as hereinafter described for the transmission and distribution of gas in and under the following public streets, lanes, highways, and places of the Town of Braintree and the pipes, valves, governors, manholes and other structures, fixtures and appurtenances designed or intended to protect or operate said mains and accomplish the objects of said Company; and the digging up and opening the ground to lay or place same:

To install and maintain approximately 430 feet, more or less of 2 inch gas main in Carter Road from the existing 2 inch gas main at Pond Street Southerly to the proposed 2 inch gas main at Butler Road and approximately 415 feet more or less of 2 inch gas main at Wayne Avenue, Braintree. All of which to replace and abandon the existing gas mains in Carter Road and Butler Road.

Petition #11 050 was unanimously approved by Council with the following conditions:

DPW: Carter Road and Butler Road from off Pond Street to off Wayne Avenue. Neither road has been resurfaced for several years, except that a "High Friction Surface" crosswalk was constructed across Butler Road at Wayne Avenue. This should be left intact if possible to avoid what may be a difficult repair. No cutting of Pond Street is requested so none should be allowed. Other than those two items, it is our recommendation that this petition **should be approved with our "standard" repair specifications, with any temporary pavement being maintained flush with the surrounding pavement until final repair.**
